## August Updates!

- ❖ **GRASS ROOTS** gave away **15 tubs** of “rescued” school supplies and related materials to over two dozen people attending a recent Perrysburg Farmers Market. Another **3 tubs** of supplies were donated to teachers in the Fremont School District, with the remainder of materials given to Goodwill or recycled. **We hope to do even better in 2026 with a full year to accept school supplies from our recycling members!**
- ❖ **GRASS ROOTS** is finishing its **3<sup>rd</sup> farm building reclamation project**, this one in northern Lucas County. We have reclaimed an extensive amount of locally milled Great Black Swamp Forest hardwood over 100 years old, mostly oak with some walnut, chestnut and other species. Thanks to Dave T. and his family for the opportunity to reclaim and reuse such an important part of our past!
- ❖ We will be starting our **4<sup>th</sup> farm building reclamation project** in Wood County in September! If you have or know of anyone who has an old farm building no longer being used that needs to be removed, we will gladly complete a free inspection to determine if it is a candidate for a future **GRASS ROOTS’** reclamation project!
